## Belong To Many Won Many Hearts

When **Belong To Many** was sold for \$525,000 at the recent Inglis Broodmare Sales, it was a bittersweet moment for her 800 owners. The fact that she brought such a good price in a difficult market was pleasing, but to know that she will now race in someone else's colours took some of the shine off the moment. For Barbara, it was a sad time, as she had nurtured this wonderful mare from a yearling and had seen her realise her potential. No matter how hard we try, these magnificent animals win our hearts and it is very difficult to part company.

The **Belong To Many** (Belong To Me/Foil) story is well documented. She was purchased by Shelley Hancox for \$20,000 at the 2005 Inglis Premier Sales and syndicated to a group of 800 owners. She had 27 starts under Barbara's care for 7 wins, 9 seconds and 3 thirds and won a total of just over \$440,000 in prize money. Her net profit is astounding and shows that you do not have to pay

millions as a yearling to be successful. Her 7 wins included a Group 2 and two listed races as well as five placings in the black-type events. In her last campaign before being sold, **Belong To Many** had five starts, all in black-type races, for 1 win, 3 seconds and 1 third. Her record, and being by the sire of the moment, **Belong To Me**, clearly supported her sale price.

The owners have had a magnificent ride with her and she must go down as one of Shelley's most successful syndications.

Joseph Racing would like to thank **Belong To Many** for her contribution to our success and wishes her new owner well in racing her and eventually breeding from her.

To Shelley Hancox, we pass on our congratulations and hope that she can replace **Belong To Many** with one just as special.

## **Winners for the Month**

**Back To Zero** impressively won his Class 1 Handicap over 1000m at Wagga on the first day of their Carnival. He followed up with a solid 5<sup>th</sup> in the Class 2 Hcp over 1000m on the second day of the Carnival. He has now won two races, with two seconds from his six starts and he will be better suited as he steps up in distance over his next few starts.

**Universal Boy** led all the way to narrowly win the Rating 72 Handicap over 1000m at Canberra. This was his fourth win from 17 starts and he has been in the money in more than 50% of his starts.

**Onthelookout** scored his second win in the Class 1 Handicap over 1200m at the Wagga Carnival. The win made it successive Wagga Carnival wins for him, as at his first start, he won the 2YO Maiden at the corresponding meeting last year beating **Back To Zero**. Like **Back To Zero** he has won two races with two seconds in his six starts. His win rounded off a good few weeks for the Sexton family, as they also own **Universal Boy**.

## **Wagga Carnival**

As usual, Barbara took a strong contingent to Wagga for the three days of their Carnival. From her 14 runners, she had two winners and two thirds. Joseph Racing had hoped for a more rewarding result, but with the city trainers targeting the Carnival, it is becoming harder to get a winner.

However, the racing is only part of the Carnival and many of Barbara's owners thoroughly enjoyed Cup Day in the Joseph Racing Marquee. Photos will be included in next month's Newsletter.
